

## Provision no. D80 By the Dean of SF USB 1 June 2017

## On the admission transfer of foreign students to Czech doctoral study programmes

All foreigner students, with the exception of citizens of the Slovak Republic, applying for Czech doctoral study programmes, or requesting a transfer from an English to a Czech study programme, need to demonstrate their basic knowledge of Czech at level B2, in accordance with the criteria specified in the Common European Reference Framework for Languages. The applicants will confirm their knowledge of Czech by submitting the confirmation of successful completion of the Certified Examination in Czech for Foreigners (CCE) obtained from an organization authorised to issue such a certificate.

This Provision comes into effect on 1 June 2017.
